Geography

Exploring school environment, identify environments dinosaurs lived in and recreate in the classroom. Gather natural materials
Look globes, and maps to find out where dinosaurs have been found.
Use geographical vocabulary to describe environments

Maths

Measuring the size of dinosaurs on the playground, use standard and non standard units of measure
Weighing ingredients when baking
Explore time through dinosaur timeline
Addition and subtraction with numbers up to 20,
Place value, 100 square work
Data Handling - make a Bar chart of favourite dinosaurs
Museum shop and entrance fees, make tickets, give change, use correct coins
