

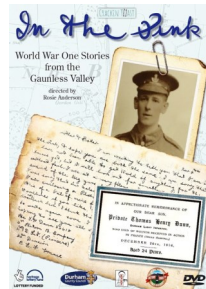

Children in Need- Friday 16th November

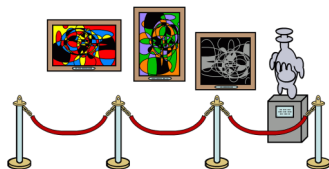
