Please join us in school on Wednesday 19th June at 2.30pm.

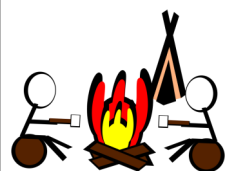
Woodland Football Tournament—Monday 24th June 2019—10.00am start
