## FOWS—Family Games Night with Hot Dogs—Tuesday 24th March

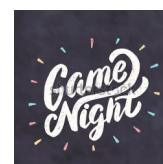
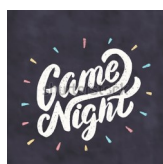
