Places are still available for pupils in Key Stage 2 to learn to play the flute or recorder with Mrs Unwin.



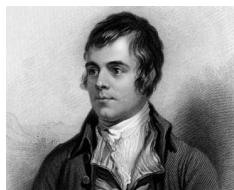
