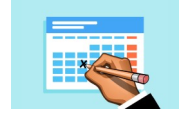




# WOODLAND SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 15th July 2022

## Uniform & PE Kits from September 2022

In the new academic year starting 7th September 2022, please ensure that your child brings their PE kit into school, this will be kept in school for the term. A PE kit should consist of a red t-shirt, navy jogging bottoms, shorts or navy leggings. A school jumper or a hoodies of your choice can also be provided.

Full school uniform should also be worn every day. This should consist of a white polo shirt, a red jumper or cardigan with grey or black trousers, skirt, shorts or pinafore dress. In summer, children may wear a summer dress. Appropriate footwear should also be worn, this should be black shoes.

## Breakfast & Afterschool Care Clubs

From September the cost for breakfast club each day will be £2.50 which brings it in line with after school care. We have not raised the price since it was established 8 years ago, but we have had to increase it this year due to rising costs.





### School Lunches

Just to let you know that the school meal price will be £2.25 per day for Year 3 to Year 6 children from 7th September. The government have agreed to continue with free universal school meals for Reception to Year 2 children. Nursery meals cost £2.70.
